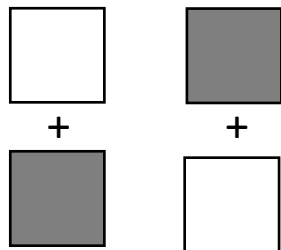


Scrappy 4-Patch

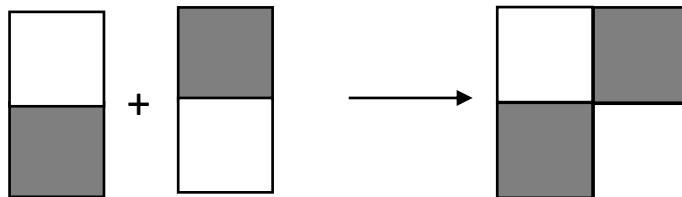


Creating 4-Patches

Medium and Dark $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
Light $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares



Layer units with the opposite colors facing. Sew down the length. Press seam allowance to the side. Create 4-Patches measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



4-Patches measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

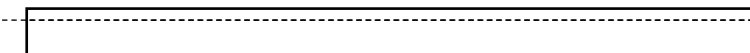
If you have leftover $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips or Jelly Rolls, then you can create your 4-Patches as shown below.

Layer right sides together. Sew down the lengthwise edge of the strip. Press the seam allowance toward the darker color. The strip should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x length of the strip.

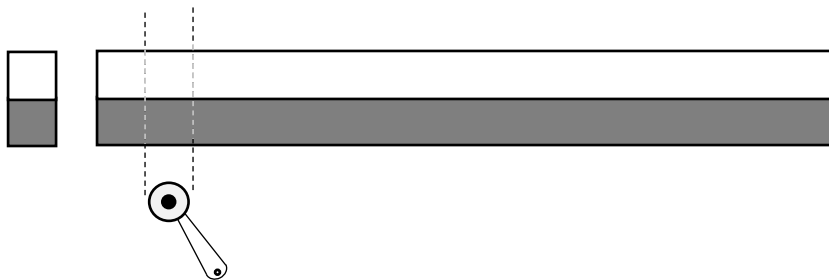
Hint: When pressing, be careful not to skew the strip.



Create 2 strips measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF



Subcut the strips into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " units.



Layer units with the opposite colors facing. Sew down the length. Press seam allowance to the side. Create 4-Patches measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Create as many 4-Patches you need for your project. You could alternate them with a plain $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
