


Serappy Irish Chain Block

10 ½" block




Fabric and Cutting Directions for 1 block:

Background 2 ½" squares – 2 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles – 2 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles – 2


Scrappy Colors 2 ½" squares - 13

Sew units into rows, measuring 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Sew rows together to create a 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block.



Think about your layout. If you want the rings as shown on the last page, you will need an even number of blocks – for example, a 6 x 8 layout for a total of 48 blocks.




Serappy Irish Chain Block
