Fabric and Cutting Directions for 1 block:

$21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares -2
$21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - 2
$21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles - 2

## Scrappy Colors

$21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares - 13

Sew units into rows, measuring $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Sew rows together to create a $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block.
