## Step 4 - Creating 4-Patches



## Scrappy Fabric

2" scrappy squares - 2 per block
Queen-200
Twin-172
Lap - 144

## Background Fabric

2" squares - 2 per block
Queen - 200
Twin-172
Lap - 144

Create 2-patches (see chart to the right for the number of 2-patches needed for your size). Match a scrappy 2" square with a background 2" square. The 2-patches should measure $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3{ }^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$. Press the seam allowance toward the scrappy color.

Sew the 2-patches together with the scrappy color opposite the background color. The 4-patches should measure $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


This is a great block for chain sewing.

Other than the number of blocks needed, this is an easy step.

Twin-86
lap-72
