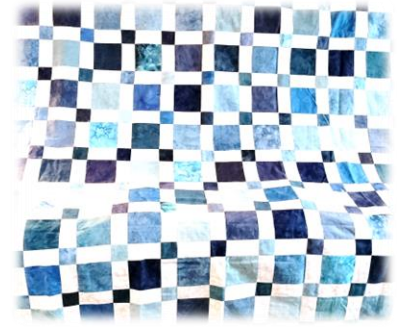
**Scrappy Fabric**

4 1/2" squares

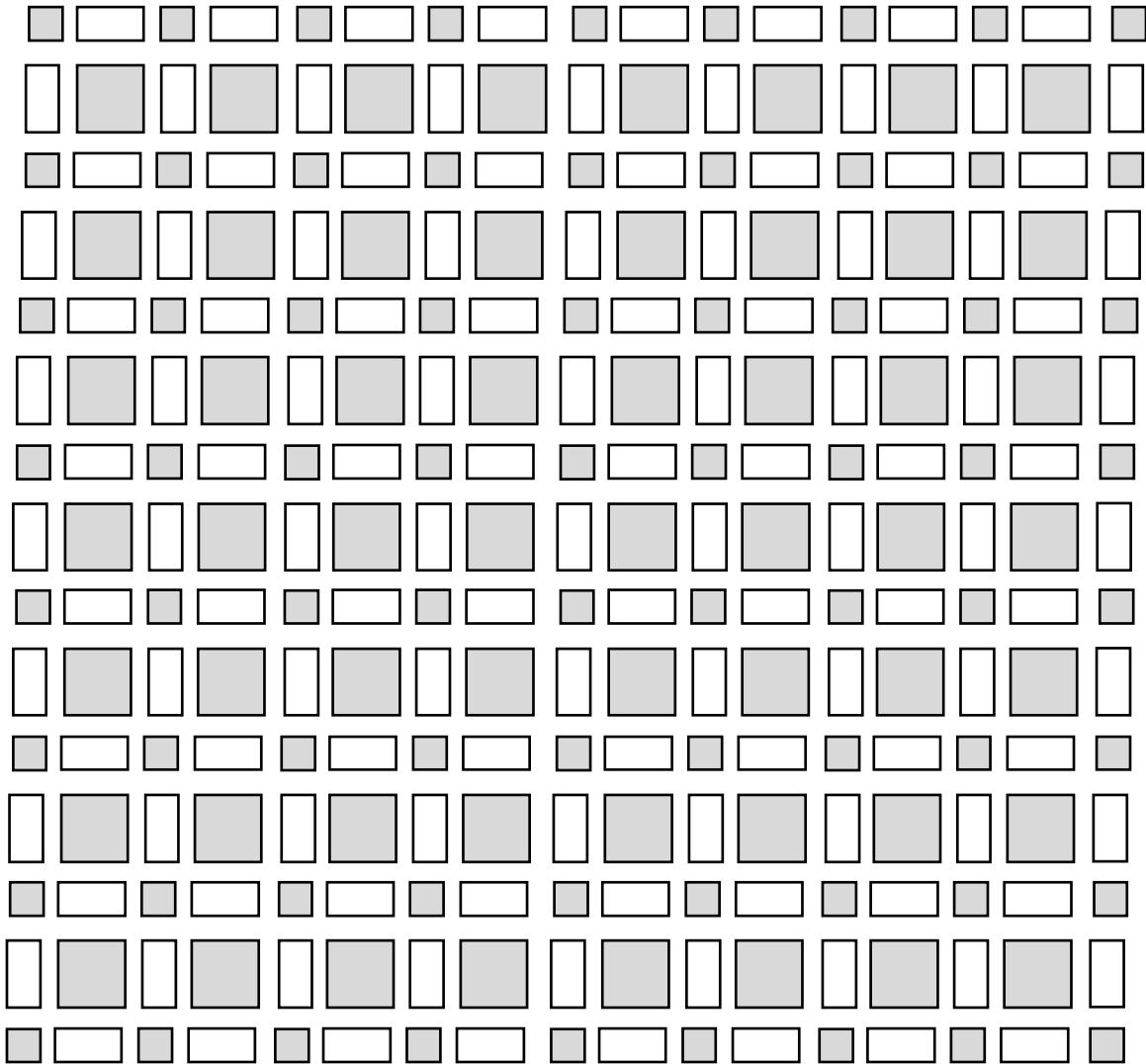
**Background Fabric**

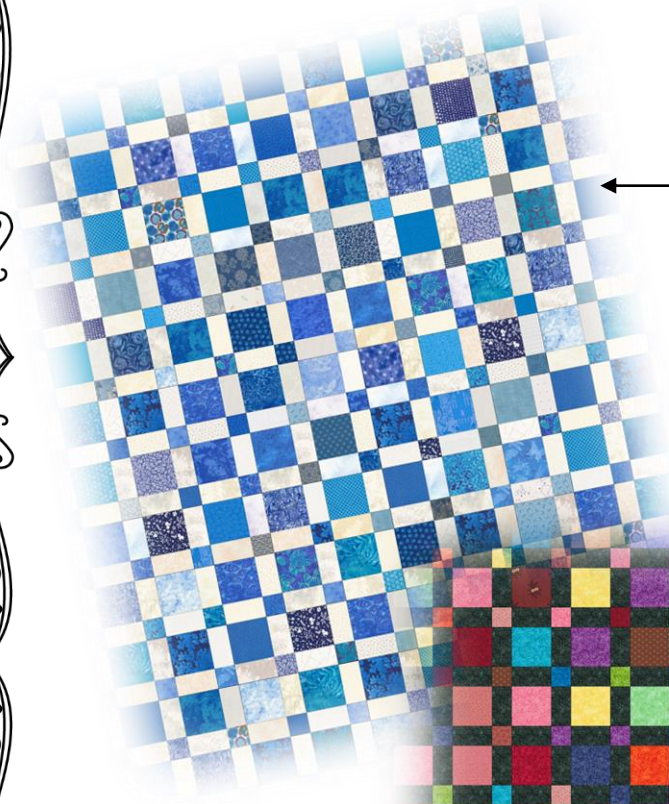
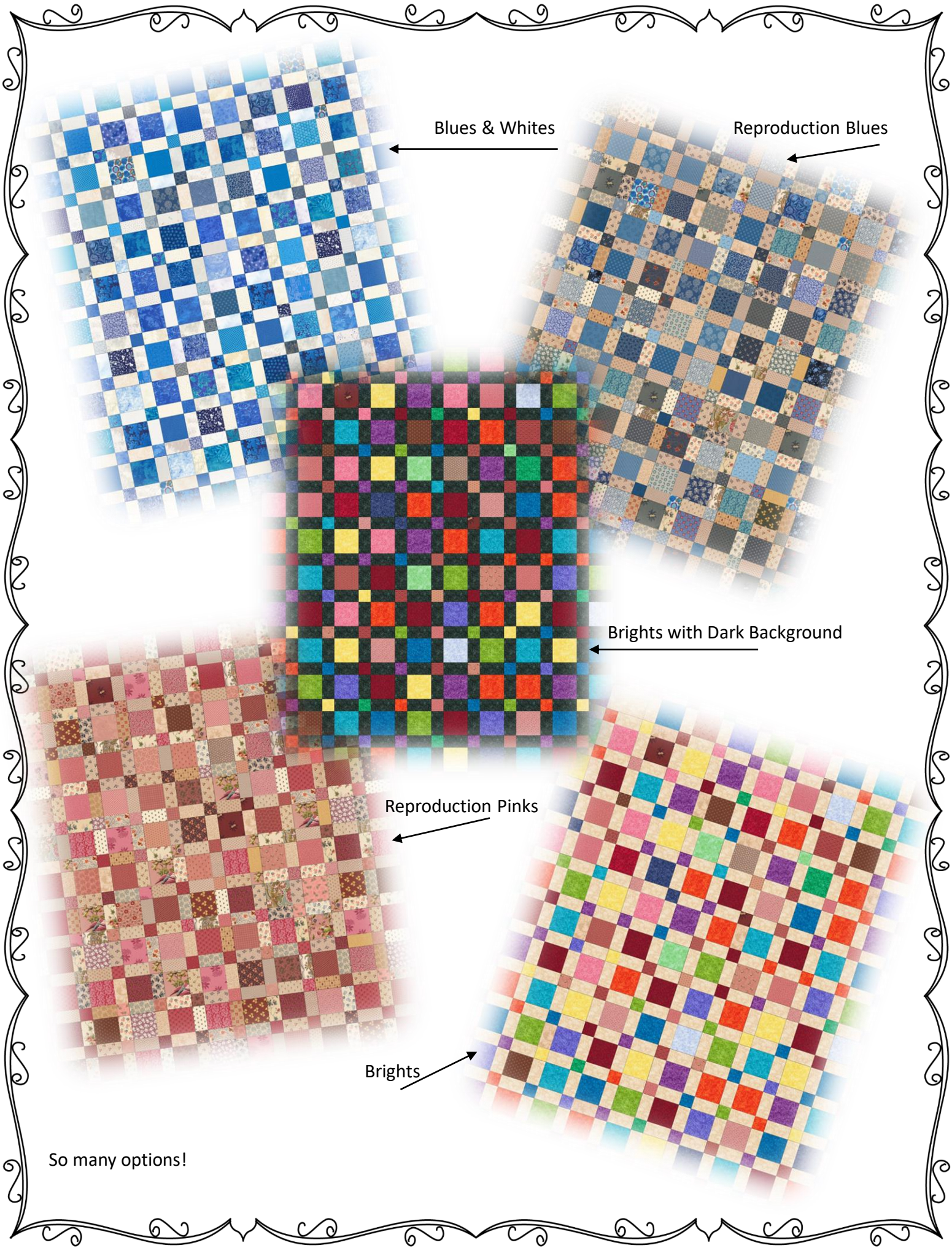
2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles



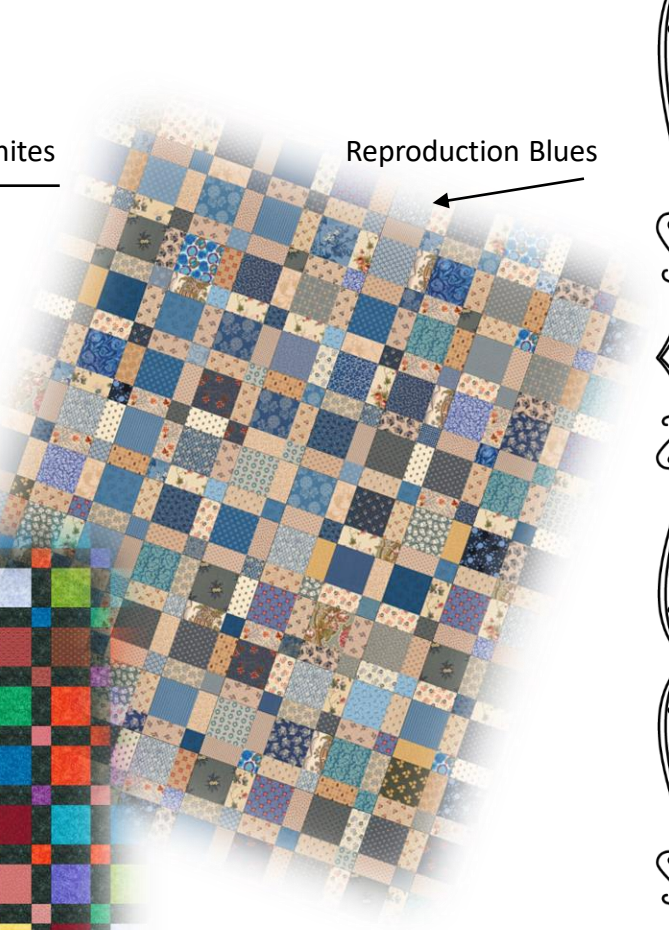
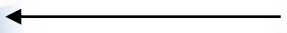
This is such a simple quilt, but the results are stunning. Do you have beautiful prints that you want to showcase? This is perfect. Do you collect blues, pinks, and greens? Add a neutral background to showcase those fabrics. Do you love reproduction fabrics? What a wonderful way to display them than in this pattern! The possibilities are endless.

Sew your units into rows. Press the seam allowance toward the scrappy fabrics. The number of units in each row depends on the size you want to make your quilt. NOTE: the more fabrics you use, the better the results. You will have more impressive results if you make the quilt bigger.

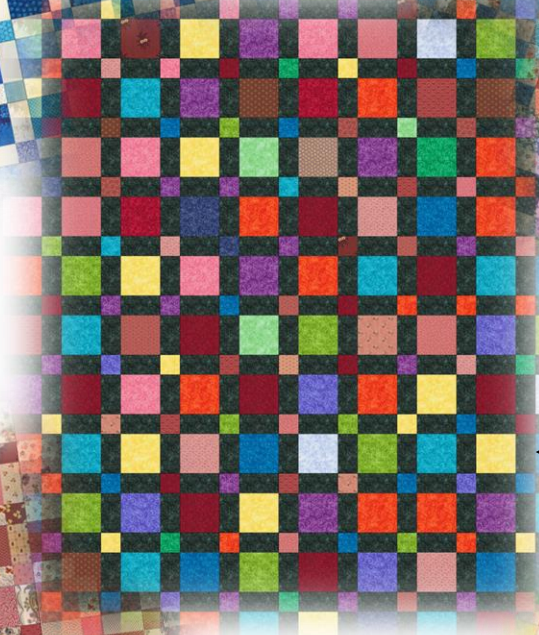




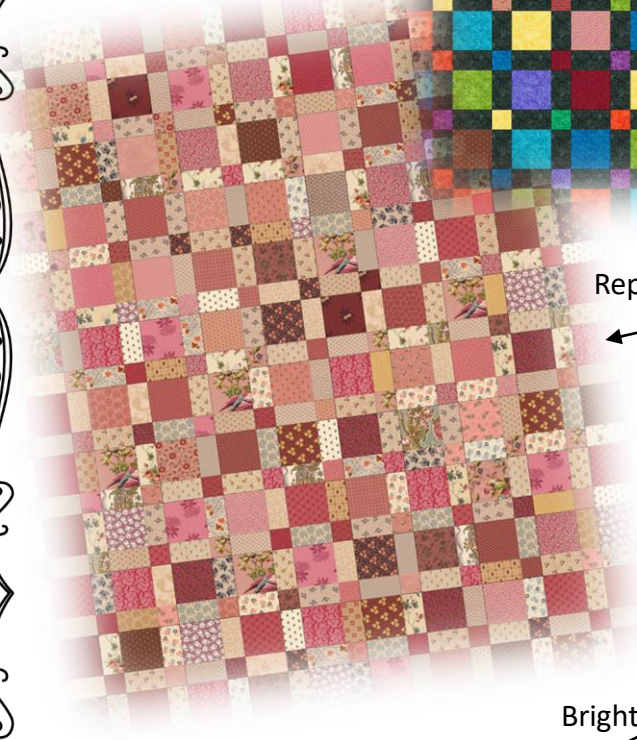
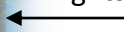
