

Row Seven Bow Tie Blocks

You'll need the following to create 12 Bow Tie Blocks:

Background

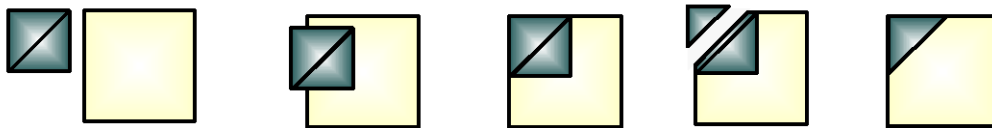
3 1/2" squares – 24

Scrappy - (I am using 6 colors)

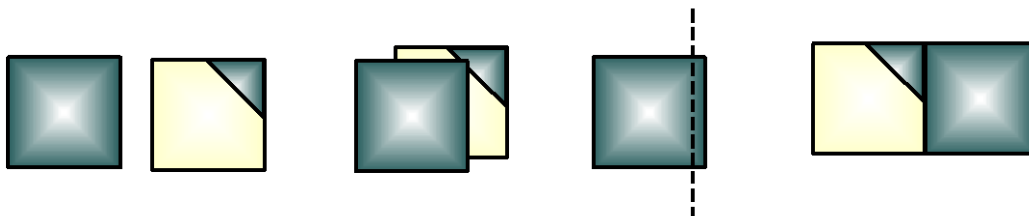
3 1/2" squares - 24 (4 from each color)

2" squares - 24 (4 from each color)

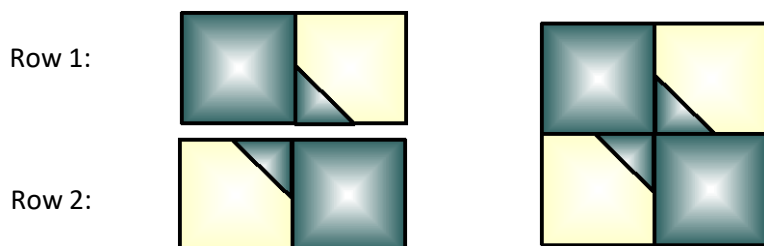
Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 2" scrappy squares. Layer a scrappy square with the Background square, right sides together. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line toward the outside corner, as shown. Press the seam allowance toward the darker color. Create 24 units measuring 3 1/2".



Layer the above units with a matching color 3 1/2" scrappy square, right sides together and sew. Press the seam allowance toward the Scrappy Color square. Create 24 units measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



To create the block, you need 2 units of the same color. Layer them right sides together. Pay attention to the orientation of the units, see diagram. Sew and press the seam allowance to the side. Create 12 blocks measuring 6 1/2".



Create 12 Bow Tie blocks measuring 6 1/2" square. Decide on your layout and color arrangement. Sew the blocks together to create a row measuring 6 1/2" x 72 1/2".
