## Row Nine Flying Geese Blocks

You'll need the following to create 12 Heart Blocks: Background

3 1/2" squares – 48

Scrappy - (I am using 6 colors)
3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles - 24 (4 of each color)

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Background squares. Layer a Background square on the Scrappy color squares, as shown in the diagrams. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the diagonal line toward the outside corner. Press seam allowance toward the Background fabric. Repeat the process on the other corner, as shown in the diagram. Create 24 Flying Geese blocks measuring 3 1/2" x 6 1/2".



Take a moment to try different layouts. There are several ways you could layout the Flying Geese blocks. Let your imagination fly!

Option 1: Sew the Flying Geese into sets of two and rotate the direction they are going.



**Option 2: S**ew the Flying Geese all going the same direction.



**Option 3:** Sew half of the Flying Geese going one direction and the other half going the opposite direction.



Create 24 Flying Geese blocks measuring 3 1/2"  $\times$  6 1/2" square. Decide on your layout and color arrangement. Sew the blocks together to create a row measuring 6 1/2"  $\times$  72 1/2".
