







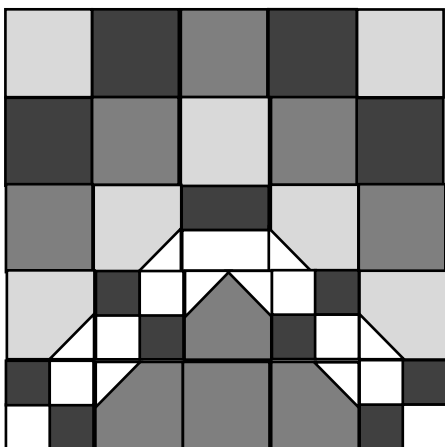
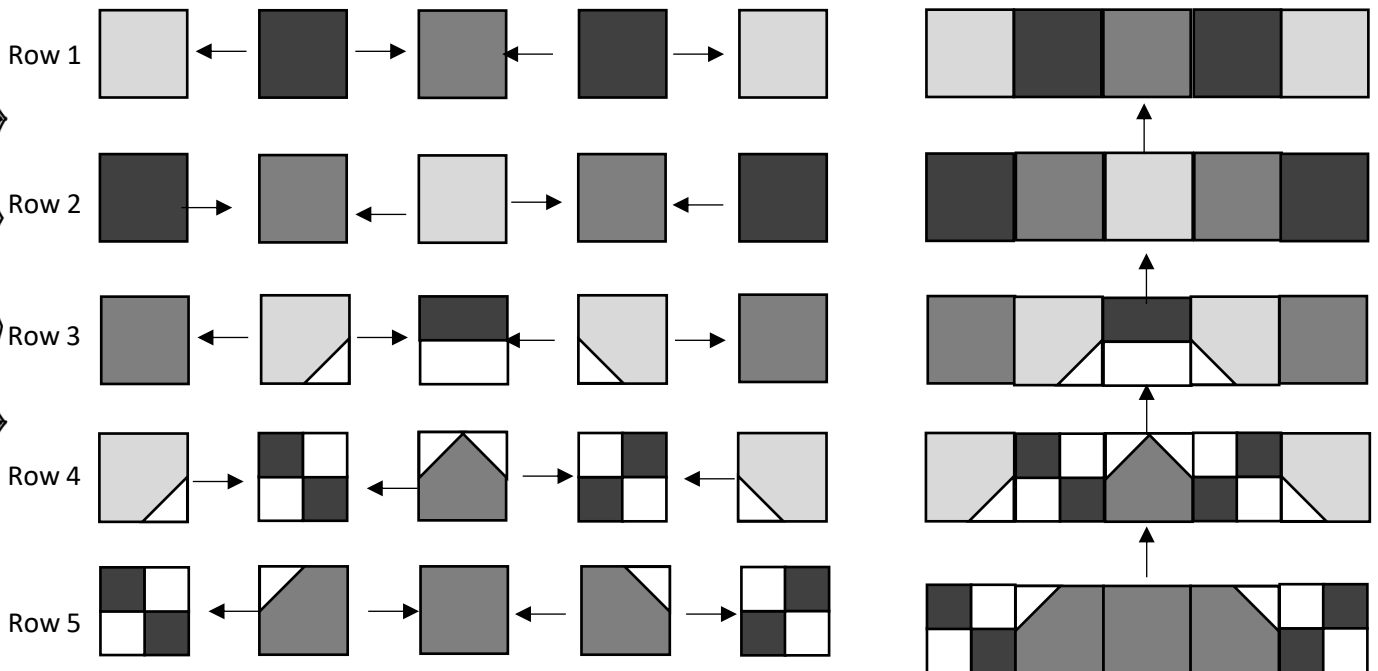


## Step Nine: Block 3

### You'll need the following:

	Medium-Light: 2 1/2" squares - 12		QT1 - 16		2R - 4		4-Patches #2 - 16
	Medium-Dark: 2 1/2" squares - 24		QT2 - 8		HT2 - 4		
	Dark: 2 1/2" squares - 16						

Using the diagram below, sew the units into rows. **Pay close attention to the orientation of the units**, otherwise you will lose the emerging pattern. Press the seam allowance in the direction of the arrow. Each row should measure 2 1/2" x 10 1/2". Sew the rows together. Press the seam allowance in the direction of the arrows.



Create 4 blocks measuring 10 1/2".  
Label them Block #3.
