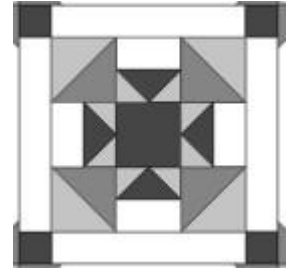


June 2026 Block of the Month



You'll need the following:

Background

2" x 9 1/2" rectangles - 4

2" x 3 1/2" rectangles - 4

Color #1

4 1/4" squares - 2 (draw diagonal line on the wrong side)

2" squares - 8 (draw diagonal line on the wrong side)

Color #2

4 1/4" squares - 2

Color #3

2" squares - 4

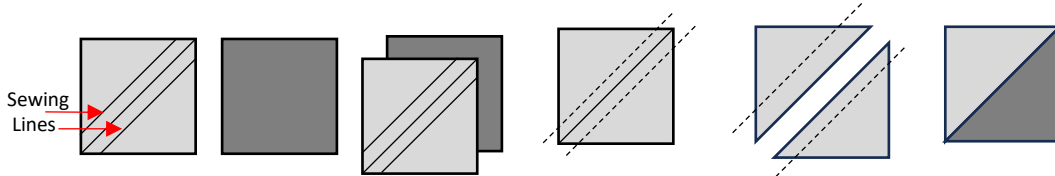
2" x 3 1/2" rectangles - 4

3 1/2" square - 1

Creating Half Square Triangles - (HST)

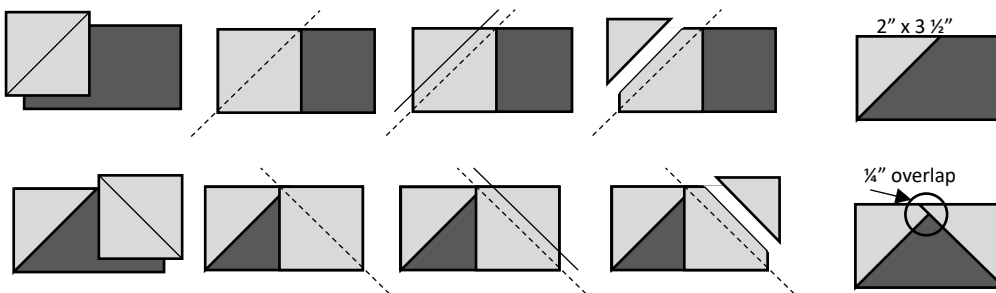
You will be using the 4 1/4" Color #1 squares and the 4 1/4" Color #2 squares to create HSTs. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Color #1 squares. Draw another diagonal line on both sides of the first line, 1/4" away from the first line. The second set of lines is your sewing lines.

Once you have sewn on both the outside lines, cut apart on the middle line using your rotary cutter and ruler. Finger press open to prevent distortion. Press the fabrics toward the darker fabric. Create 4 HSTs that measure 3 1/2".



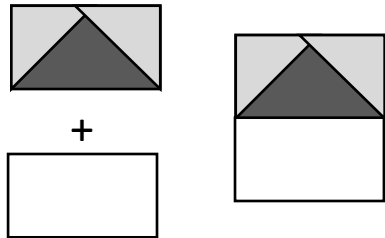
Trim the HSTs to 3 1/2" for the best result; trim from all 4 sides of the HST.

Layer Color #1 2" square on the Color #3 2" x 3 1/2" rectangle right sides together, as shown in the diagram. Pay attention to the direction of the drawn line. Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" from the line toward the outside corner. Carefully press the Color #2 piece toward the outside without stretching it. Repeat on the other corner as shown in the diagram. Pay close attention to the direction you are sewing that second square. Create 4 flying geese measuring 2" x 3 1/2".

Time to add the flying geese to the Background rectangle. See the diagram below.



Press the seam allowance to the side. Create 4 measuring 3 1/2" squares.

Layout the units as shown in Step 1 below. Sew the center block together as shown in Step 2. Pay close attention to the orientation of the units. Add the outside border as shown in Step 3. Press the seam allowance to the side. Your block should measure 12 1/2".
